<b>put ... down (1)</b>	...を下に置く	Please <b>put</b> your glass <b>down</b> and come and help me.
<b>put ... down... on (2)</b>	(頭金)を支払	I needed to <b>put down</b> a deposit of \$1000 <b>on</b> my car.
<b>put ... down (3)</b>	...をこきおろす。...にケチをつける	You shouldn't <b>put</b> other people <b>down</b> like that.
<b>put ... down (4)</b>	(年老いた動物)を安楽死させる	My dog was old, blind and in pain, so I asked the vet to <b>put</b> him <b>down</b> .

<b>lay ... down (1)</b>	...を(優しく)下に置く、寝かせる	You can <b>lay</b> your baby <b>down</b> over there.
<b>lay down one's life for</b>	(~のために)命を捧げる	He is a hero who <b>laid down his life</b> for our country.

<b>look down</b>	(を)見下ろす	If you <b>look down</b> you can see the Grand Canyon on your left.
<b>look down on</b>	...を軽蔑する	Drug users are really <b>looked down on</b> in Japan.
