<b>throw... in (3)</b>	~を(牢屋に) ぶち込む	The police <b>threw</b> the suspected terrorists <b>in</b> jail.
<b>throw in the towel</b>	諦める、降参する	Learning the piano was too difficult for me, so I <b>threw in the towel</b> .

<b>turn in</b>	床に入る	It's way past midnight. It's high time we <b>turned in</b> .
<b>turn ... in (1)</b>	(宿題など) を提出する	I have to <b>turn in</b> my report tomorrow morning.
<b>turn ... in (2)</b>	~を(警察に) 引き渡す・届ける	The criminal <b>turned himself in</b> to the police.
<b>turn ... in (3)</b>	(成果など) を収める・達成する	Sony <b>turned in</b> a good sales performance despite mediocre products.
