7	<b>It's affordable.</b>	<i>The clothes at Uniqlo are affordable, but not really cheap unless on sale.</i>

#### Expensive

8	<b>It costs a fortune!</b>	<i>Take-away pizzas in Japan cost a fortune!</i>
9	<b>That's a rip-off!</b>	<i>What? You want me to pay \$20? That's a rip-off!</i>
10	<b>I can't afford it.</b>	<i>I'm sorry, I can't afford a Lexus... Toyota cars are more affordable.</i>
11	<b>That's a bit pricey.</b>	<i>Hmm, \$150 for a Gucci T-shirt? That's a bit pricey.</i>
12	<b>It costs an arm and a leg.</b>	<i>It costs an arm and a leg to get braces.</i>
13	<b>That's too much.</b>	<i>I want to make a fence, but the price you are asking is just too much.</i>
14	<b>I'll give you \$~ for it. Take it or leave it.</b>	<i>I'll give you \$5 for it. Take it or leave it.</i>
