<b>look to (for~, to do)</b>	(~を/~することを)に頼る	Don't <b>look to</b> me for support.
<b>run to ...</b>	...に助けを求めて駆け寄る	Every time I scold you, you <b>run to</b> your mother.
<b>stick to (1)</b>	...にくっつく	The snowball he threw at me <b>stuck to</b> the tree.
<b>stick to (2)</b>	固執する	I think it is unnecessary to <b>stick to</b> silly customs and rituals.
<b>stick to (3)</b>	(信念、人に) 忠実である	My wife <b>stuck to</b> me through thick and thin.
<b>turn to (1)</b>	(新しい課題)に移る	After talking about politics, I will <b>turn to</b> a different topic.
<b>turn to (2)</b>	(感情などが) 変わる	Her laughter <b>turned to</b> horror when she saw his face.
<b>turn to ~ (for) (3)</b>	(を求めて)に頼っていく	I <b>turned to</b> her for help because I didn't know what to do.
<b>come under (1)</b>	の部類・項目に入る	For accounting purposes, meal expenses <b>come under</b> "travel".
<b>come under</b> (fire, attack)	(攻撃・批判など)に見舞われる	The Prime Minister <b>came under</b> criticism because of the scandal.
