We think if we give our kids a new iPhone or Earpods then maybe they'll be happy, and can't understand why they are miserable despite having everything they want. The thing is more often than not they don't have everything they want, because what they want can't be bought with money.

Your children don't need things. They need YOU. Give them your time, give them your ear, give them your love. It is the best gift they will ever receive.

If you feel your child is struggling with school or life, and you don't know what to do, get help. Don't wait. Don't be ashamed. Free professional help is available.


