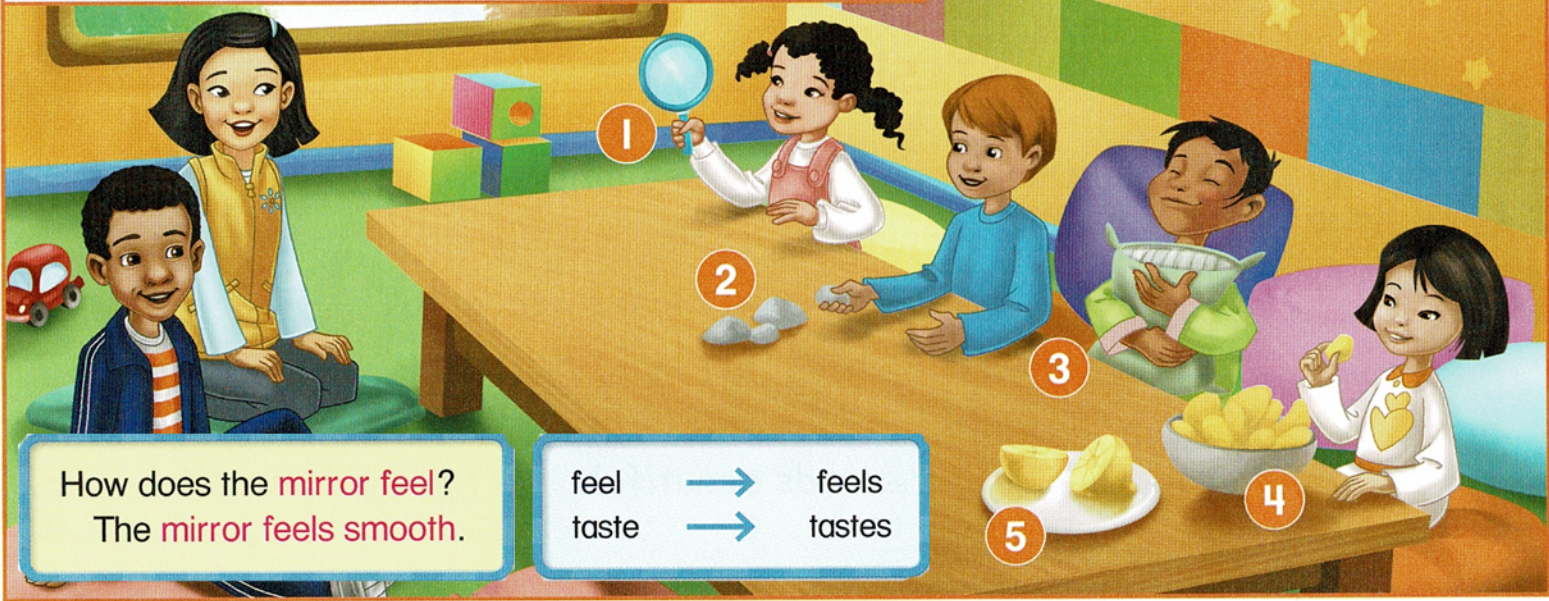












Jenny and Andy went to a day care center. They talked with the children about the senses.
