Invitations

1	Are you free ... <i>(Saturday night?)</i>	Are you free (on) Friday?
2	Are you doing anything ... <i>(tomorrow?)</i>	Are you doing anything on the weekend?
3	Do you wanna ... <i>(see a movie?)</i>	Do you wanna go out for a drink on Saturday?
4	Would you like to ... <i>(have dinner?)</i>	Would you like to have dinner with me?
5	I'd like to ask you ... <i>(out for dinner)</i>	I'd like to ask you to my birthday party.
6	Can I ask you ... <i>(out on a date?)</i>	Can I ask you out for dinner next week?

Responding to invitations

7	I'd love to!	Do you wanna have dinner with me? <i>I'd love to!</i>
8	Sounds great.	How about French for dinner? <i>Sounds great!</i>
9	Sure, I look forward to it.	So let's meet on Sunday at 12. <i>Sure, I look forward to it.</i>
10	That would be great.	Do you wanna meet tomorrow? <i>That would be great!</i>
11	Let me check my calendar.	Do you wanna see a movie with me on Friday? <i>Let me check my calendar.</i>
12	I'm sorry I have another commitment.	Do you want to have tea tomorrow? <i>I'm sorry I have another commitment.</i>
13	Maybe another time.	Do you want to go on date with me? <i>Maybe another time.</i>

- Do you often invite people out, or wait for someone to invite you?
