### Introducing Yourself

1	<b>Let me introduce myself. I'm ~</b>	Good afternoon. Let me take a moment to introduce myself. I'm Philip
2	<b>I don't think we've met before. I'm ~</b>	Hi there, I don't think we've met before, have we? I'm Philip.
3	<b>I just wanted to say hello. I'm ~</b>	Mr. Abe, I just wanted to say hello and thank you for all you do for rich people.

### Introducing someone else

4	<b>I'd like you to meet ~</b>	Mum, I'd like you to meet Sadako, my new girlfriend.
5	<b>Have you met ~ ?</b>	Hey, have you met the new exchange student yet?
6	<b>I'd like to introduce you to ~</b>	Mr. Thompson, I'd like to introduce you to my mother.
7	<b>This is ~</b>	Phil, this is Noriko. Noriko, Phil.

### Responding to an introduction (Can also be used at the beginning)

8	<b>It's a pleasure to meet you.</b>	It's a pleasure to meet you Noriko. I've heard your lessons are amazing.
9	<b>I'm honored to meet you.</b>	I'm honored to meet you Mr. Einstein.
10	<b>The pleasure is all mine.</b>	The answer to "a pleasure to meet you" if someone says it to you.
