### Saying Sorry

1	<b>I'm sorry for ....</b> (reason)	<i>I'm sorry for being late. I'm soooooo sorry for being late again.</i>
2	<b>Forgive me.</b>	<i>You hurt me with your words! I'm so sorry. Forgive me.</i>
3	<b>I'd like to apologize ....</b> (reason)	<i>Mrs. Thompson, I'd like to apologize for breaking your window.</i>
4	<b>It's (all) my fault.</b>	<i>I'm sorry I asked you to come with me. No, no, it's my fault I crashed the car.</i>
5	<b>I (It) was wrong.</b>	<i>I'm sorry for lying to you. It was wrong.</i>
6	<b>Oops, my bad (mistake).</b> (small mistakes) (	<i>Where's the chocolate ice-cream? Oops, my bad. I ate it.</i>
7	<b>I should have ... I shouldn't have ...</b>	<i>After saying sorry, you use this to explain that you have learned from your mistake. I'm sorry, it's my fault. I should have checked before throwing out your homework.</i>
8	<b>I take full responsibility for ...</b>	<i>I know what I did was wrong. I take full responsibility for my actions.</i>

### Responding to an Apology

1	<b>That's okay.</b>	<i>I'm sorry for saying you're stupid. That's okay.</i>
2	<b>No problem. (No worries)</b>	<i>Sorry for bumping into you. No worries.</i>
3	<b>It happens.</b>	<i>Oops, my bad. I'm sorry I spilled the milk. Don't worry, it happens.</i>
4	<b>Don't worry about it.</b>	<i>I'm sorry for breaking your plate. Don't worry about it.</i>
5	<b>Apology accepted.</b>	<i>I'm sorry I kissed your boyfriend. Apology accepted.</i>
6	<b>We all make mistakes.</b>	<i>It was wrong to cheat on the test. We all make mistakes.</i>
